

Motion made to set this in writing and minutes (1 Pat Weber) and (2 Robert C.) all voted aye, passed. Car pooling will be encouraged as no single person vehicles will be compensated. PROMOTIONS- Marine for life Program, Marines Helping Marines Program, Honor Guard, Firing Squad Bugler, and Color Guard.



PROGRAMS- Recruiting, membership events, BBQ's, Picnics, assisting with the reserve unit, Welcome home event, activities with other veterans' groups, and support of you Devil Dog Pound.

COMMUNITY EVENTS OR SUPPORT- Toys for Tots, Parades, ceremonies or other civic events. YOUTH- Youth programs, Eagle Scout Honor Courts, Scholarship Programs, Student Awards, Young Marines, JROTC, respect for the flag classes, etc.

The overall top award for this Americanism Report is the Gil Gray Award. The Gil Gray Award is the most distinguished award to the winning detachment that shows their hard work and Esprit De Corps.
