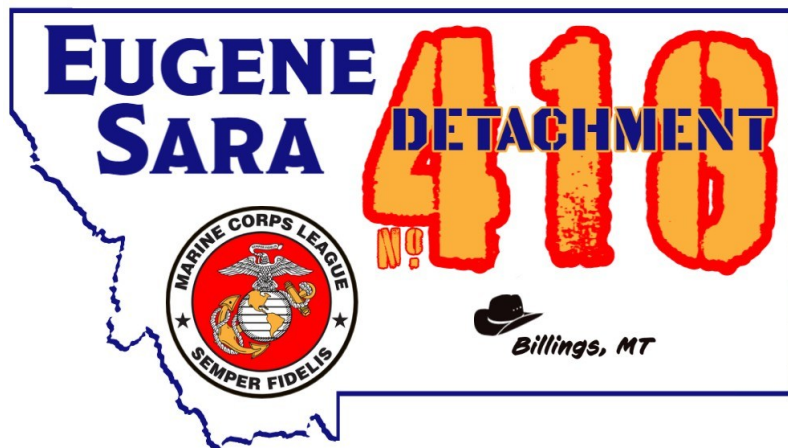

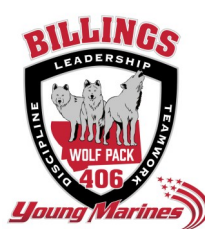
### **Senior Vice Commandant Report:**
